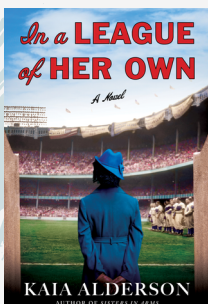

BOOKS THAT BIND BOOK CLUB

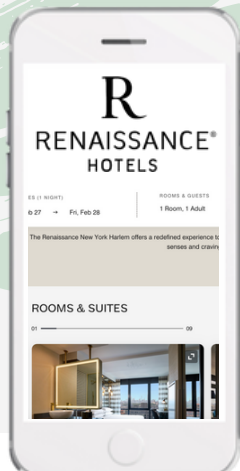
THE RUTH PEALE LIBRARY

MISSION MASTERY TIPS & TRICKS FOR NON-PROFITS

Important changes are on the horizon for nonprofits! IRS filing deadlines are approaching, so be sure to submit your Form 990 on time to maintain compliance. If your fiscal year ended in October, your deadline is March 17, 2025—don't miss it!

Additionally, federal funding changes may impact grant disbursements, with some temporary pauses and legal challenges affecting nonprofit budgets. It's crucial to stay informed and assess how these shifts may impact your organization.

Finally, new executive orders related to DEI initiatives and nonprofit policies are under review, with potential implications for operations and funding eligibility. Advocacy and legal guidance may be needed to navigate these changes.

Stay proactive—monitor updates, engage with advocacy efforts, and consult legal counsel to ensure your organization remains compliant and prepared for what's ahead!
