Your risk of becoming ill when traveling depends on:

- Areas to be visited.
- Length of stay.
- Your pre-existing medical conditions.
- Your vaccine history.

Because of differences in living standards, immunization coverage, and sanitary conditions, your risk of becoming ill increases, particularly if you are traveling in rural areas of developing countries.



Why do I need a Travel Health Consultation?

While immunizations and medications are important to get before you travel, educating yourself about your destination will help you have a successful trip.

During your consultation, your travel health professional can review aspects of your destination and explain how risks can be prevented, minimized, or if necessary, treated.

Your consultation may include:

- Food, water, and transportation safety.
- Crime and political information.
- Travel advisories.
- Environmental concerns.
- Health concerns and disease outbreaks.
- Recommended and mandatory immunizations.
- Malaria medications, if necessary.
- Consulate and Embassy contact information.
- Advice on what to bring with you: insect repellent, clothing, sunblock, over-the-counter medication, etc.
- Seeking health care abroad.
- Interacting with local residents.
